

About solusvm.conf file on Master Node

The `/usr/local/solusvm/includes/solusvm.conf` file contains the information regarding database connection. File contains a string divided by ``:`` delimiter in the following format:

```
<DATABASE_NAME>:<USER>:<PASSWORD>:<HOST>:<ENCRYPTION_KEY>
```

For example:

```
# cat /usr/local/solusvm/includes/solusvm.conf
Vmf7LEAnrb5S8x6:218H3lW42EkJZ1y:GOJebeWE10IOaciXhnM27OryQfQikF:localhost:
XFrORvKb69F1QDlmJ6hDqg374iQjL2ndgGIETkYFTixpFIYFQ0
```

Here, **Vmf7LEAnrb5S8x6** is the database name, **218H3lW42EkJZ1y** is database user, **GOJebeWE10IOaciXhnM27OryQfQikF** is database password, **localhost** is the host where database server is located (default value), and encryption key is **XFrORvKb69F1QDlmJ6hDqg374iQjL2ndgGIETkYFTixpFIYFQ0**.

Note: encryption key is vital in case of Master Node migration scenario, see [Migrating SolusVM Master node to another server](#)
