

# FTP Servers

In SolusVM you can use several predefined FTP servers. This can be useful if one wants to keep Backups on different places.

To add an FTP server:

1. Go to **SolusVM admin panel > Configuration > FTP Servers** and click **Add FTP Server**
2. Fill in the FTP server settings and click **Add**:

After that predefined FTP servers can be selected for Auto FTP backup in **Profile** dropdown menu at **SolusVM admin panel > Nodes > {Node} > Auto FTP Backup**:
